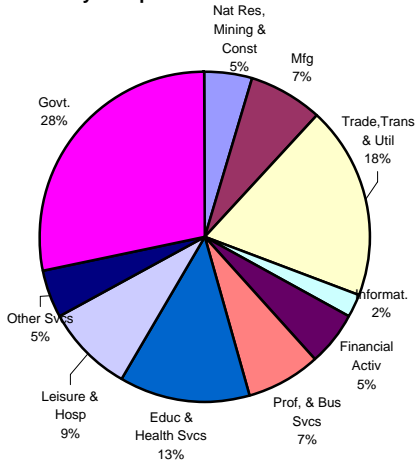
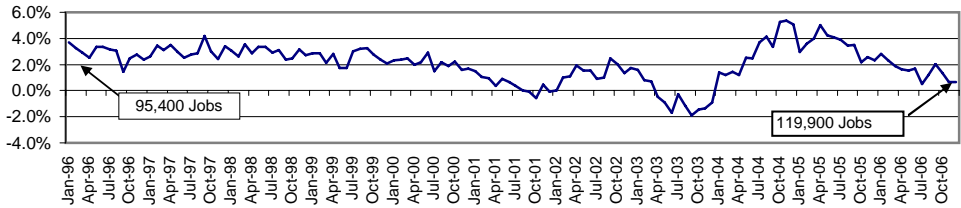


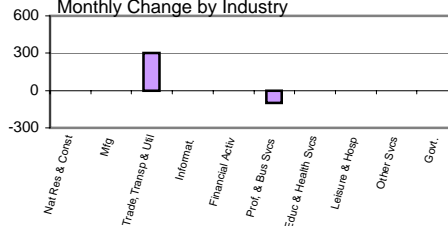
**Industry Composition**



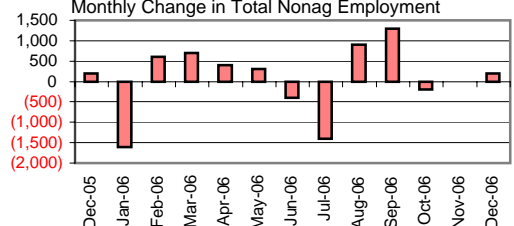
**Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment**

**Comments for December 2006**

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood MSA added 200 jobs over the month. This increase was less than the five-year average increase of 300 jobs and was also the first over-the-month increase since September. Since December 2005, 800 jobs have been added, a 0.7 percent increase in employment. The largest over-the-month increase for the area happened in the Retail Trade Sector. The sector had a seasonal increase of 200 jobs as area retailers increased staff for the holiday shopping season. December's increase was the second consecutive over-the-month increase and was also twice the size of the five-year average increase of 100 jobs. Employment is expected to decrease in January as the holiday shopping season comes to a close.
